### **TEACHER FEATURES**

**WENDY MILLER** – Wendy is a primitive rug hooking designer and teacher. Her rug pattern business is THE RED SALTBOX. Known for her use of textured wool and primitive color palette in wide cuts, her low contrast rugs have an instant old age appearance. She hooks antique motif rugs and original designs that are influenced by all things old. Wendy is a frequent contributor to Rug Hooking Magazine and a member of ATHA.

**MARIA BARTON** – Maria is best known for her primitive style, her wonderful whimsical primitive patterns and antique reproductions. She is owner of the STAR RUG COMPANY. Her well known signature pieces are Primitive Halloween people and Sheep rugs. Maria has been hooking for over 16 years and has written articles for Rug Hooking Magazine and Wool Street Journal. In 2006 and 2007 she was recognized for her rugs in Early American Life.

**CLASS DESCRIPTION** – This will be an open team teaching class. Your pattern choice can be one of the teacher's designs or any commercial pattern from other designers. Color planning will be done with students individual in class using the large selection of wools brought by the teachers or using your own wool. Students will be required to hook in #8 cut or larger. Wendy and Marie are both wide cut primitive teachers.

**TEACHER'S FEE:** \$110.00 This is payable to the teachers at the end of the retreat. (\$55.00 for each teacher)

**RETREAT FEE:** \$315.00 per person. This includes 4 nights accommodations, all meals, linens, snacks, bottled water and soft drinks. This also includes travel expenses for the teachers.
